## NEW STUDENT PLACEMENT ADVISOR NOTES

There are three separate screening placement levels to determine proper developmental placement of students. Placement is progressive. Advisors need to follow each level (in sequence) in order to correctly place students. Reversing or skipping levels could inadvertently place a student in a developmental class incorrectly. There is no level two for English placement.

Placement scores and the high school GPA are valid for five years only. If older than 5 years, the student must take the Accuplacer. Students who meet placement criteria on the basis of approved ACT subscores or high school markers in both math and English are exempt from taking the Accuplacer. ACT composite scores are not used for placement.

## Math Placement Guidelines

A student who makes an $A$ or $B$ in precalculus or another upper level math course in high school but does not have an ACT math score of 22 or higher should take the ACCUPLACER for placement into MTH 110/112.
